## St. Mary's Ignite the Faith Capital Campaign

Our capital campaign is just over \$3.1 million pledged, and we have close to \$1.9 million in cash collected, our goal is \$3.5 million. ### Extra grain in your bins? Donate it to MLTF!

A donor gives bushels of grain to MLTF by completing a "Transfer of Ownership" form available through the Diocese of Sioux City. MLTF assumes ownership of the grain and sells it for market value. The donor receives an Iowa tax credit equal to 65% of the value of the grain on the date of donation. This tax credit can be applied to Iowa tax liability within the next 5 years. The donor does not recognize the income from the sale of the grain while also receiving Iowa tax credit from this program. (Donors are encouraged to contact their tax accountant for further clarification.)
