St. Mary's Ignite the Faith Capital Campaign

Our capital campaign is just over \$3.1 million pledged, and we have close to \$1.9 million in cash collected, our goal is \$3.5 million. To help bring in the final money needed for this project, we have been given \$350,000 to be used in a matching fund. This money will match dollar for dollar NEW FUNDS pledged or collected between now and the end of the calendar year, 2019. To date we have matched \$200,000. There is still \$150,000 available.

This is for "New Funds" only. How can you help St Mary's acquire these matching funds?

2. If you made a "One-Time" campaign gift for this year, to consider giving the same or a portion of it again.

The mission of St. Mary School is to provide a Catholic education in a Christ-Centered environment, which enables students to attain religious and academic excellence.

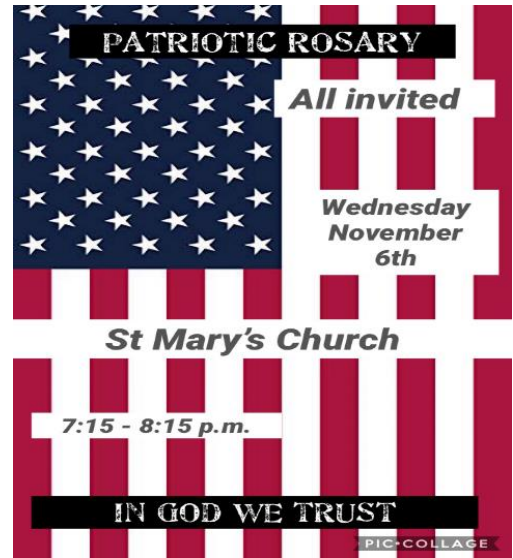
There is no school for students this Friday due to conferences. The next student liturgy, planned by Mrs. Bormann and Gr. 2 students, is November 22.
